Grading News

Donal O'Boyle is Drogheda's highest graded player yet again according to the latest grading list issued by the ICU. He now stands at 1857 with Jack Parker in second place on 1596. Andrew Thomson(1592), Philip Mitchell (1427) and Anthony Moore(1358) fill the remaining top five places. Most improved grading is Michelle Cowley who rose from 1083 to 1300. Other large

increases were Donal O'Boyle (1697 to 1857), Michael Eagleton (963 to 1117) and Kieran Rogers (1007 to 1215). Strange how the same names seem to reappear again and again - obviously they are the in-form players.
